Safety is a top priority, and you may be reassigned if you feel you are not ready for an assignment or are unable to perform it.

Background Investigation:

All prospective members will have a confidential background investigation which includes a criminal history check. It is important to the Police Authority & the team that all Search and Rescue members are of sound character and show good judgement in their personal conduct. Members will often be involved in sensitive situations requiring trust and the ability to respect confidentiality. They will also be expected to maintain the personal lifestyle of an upstanding, law-abiding citizen.
